NEED FOR INDIANIZATION OF EDUCATION - PRINCIPAL DR. GOLHAR



He pointed out the fact that while liberal arts and STEM subjects are a popular choice, the subjects like Arts, Crafts, Homeopathy, Ayurveda etc are getting overlooked.
