IQAC Report AY 2022-23

The efforts taken by IQAC of MMCC continue to ensure quality in its multi disciplinary education through well defined administrative and teaching processes supported by regular feedback from all stakeholders. The consistent efforts of all IQAC members for the 'Welfare of Masses'; has borne fruit through successful implementation of initiatives like 'Connect' for the holistic development and mental well being of the students. The IQAC has taken steps for NEP 2020 preparedness through its awareness workshop / seminar for industry institute linkages and redefining institutional perspective plans for implementing skill development and multidisciplinary education along with inculcating critical thinking & regional arts and culture as part of Indian Knowledge System.

The academic year commenced with web based Vriddhi Software for the online admission process and the academic activities as per SPPU guidelines. The faculty members strengthened e content for asynchronous learning, conducted value added courses for bridging industry requirement, organized guest lectures for higher progression, holistic development, career counseling etc and strengthened ICT facilities as part of collaboration.

The academic activities were reinforced with the establishment of:

- 1. Foreign Language Courses Center.
- 2. 'Connect' Initiative for well being of students
- 3. Electoral Literacy Club in collaboration with Maharashtra State Election and WE Foundation

The college has collaborated and undertaken various activities with a view to enhance its societal and industry connect as mentioned below.

The cultural department of the college conducted various curricular, co curricular, extracurricular & sports activities in the month of March where students demonstrated their excellence, perseverance and endurance in various competitions / events. The placement cell organized 'Mega Campus Placement Drive' on 25th May 2023 for the undergraduate students as part of collaborative activity with Magic Bus wherein eight companies; Armeka, EQL, Findrive, ICICI Bank, Inno Source, Kotak Bank, Kothari Wheels, WNS; participated for selecting the students who studied under the choice based credit system.

Alumni Meet 2022 was organized on 6th November 2022. More than 300 alumni from 1991 to 2015 gathered for the alma mater.
