	To read and confirm the minutes of the IQAC meeting dated 17 March 2023
1.	Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 17th March 2023 were confirmed by the IQAC coordinator in the presence of the Chairman and other members.
	To apprise members about various activities / events
2.	Dr. Devidas Golhar apprised members about various academic and administrative compliances / activities successfully completed by the college. He further elaborated on the curricular, co curricular, extra curricular and sports events for the students along with other activities / events (detailed report is attached as Annexure 1). The members also applauded the felicitation of Sadhvi Dhuri for Shiv Chhatrapati Award and the Art Circle students for winning twenty nine awards in various categories.
	To apprise members on the preparedness for NAAC Re-accreditation a. College Infrastructure Maintenance b. Campus Infrastructure Maintenance c. Strengthen Academic Facilitation
	d. College Website e. Academic & Administrative Audit, Submission of IIQA and preparation of SSR
	a) Dr. Sandip Anpat apprised the members of the maintenance and augmentation of college infrastructure to ensure smooth conduction of academics and as approved by CDC. The routine maintenance was proposed by various departments considering their requirements and needs for preparedness towards NAAC re accreditation.
3.	b) Dr. Sandip Anpat discussed the campus infrastructure maintenance that was approved by CDC as part of preparedness towards NEP 2020 to provide a platform for critical thinking through maintained laboratories and student facilities.
	c) Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni discussed the initiatives taken by college for students and their skill development to strengthen their academics and prepare them for employment or entrepreneurship or start ups. She also added the use of interactive boards for innovative learning approaches for the strengthening of academic facilities. Mr. Manohar Gohane discussed the use of digital institutional repository / digital library using 'DSpace' to strengthen accessibility of learning resources and strengthen academic facilitation.
	d) Mrs. Nidhi Satavlekar apprised the members of the successful implementation of the new college website and its revised content in accordance with preparedness for NAAC Re-accreditation. In addition, she mentioned the design of a NAAC landing page with the approval from CDC has been initiated.

e) Dr. Swapna Kolhatkar apprised the members of the academic and administrative audit and the recommendations towards good practices for the current academic year. She discussed the submission of Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) within the NAAC Accreditation validity period of 25th September 2023 in order to apply for Re Accreditation for 4th cycle. She added that the acceptance of IIQA by NAAC was awaited.

To strengthen activities to be conducted as part of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, Foreign Language Cell, IIRS-ISRO Nodal Center, Competitive Examination Guidance Center etc.

Prof. S M Edke discussed the initiatives undertaken by IQAC for providing a platform to the students to orient themselves for higher education / experiential learning / linguistics / multidisciplinary education etc. He discussed the various languages taught under foreign language cell where thirty students have enrolled for the current academic year. Shri Tej Niwalikar suggested providing more language options for the students and the same was agreed by all the members.

Dr. Sandip Anpat discussed the work done till date under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan project and the submission of additional proposals for the current academic year that are in process for their acceptance. Manjyotsingh Aasi further mentioned the conduction of a program under IIRS-ISRO Nodal Center in college campus to live telecast the Chandrayaan 3 landing that was attended by many students and faculty members. Dr. Sandip Anpat discussed his plans to strengthen the centre, which was agreed by all members. He also apprised the members of strengthening the Competitive Examination Guidance Center and agreed by all members.

Mr. Shridhar Loni applauded the efforts taken by IQAC for skill development in students and added that along with NSDC, the college could additionally collaborate with Maharashtra State Skills University. Additionally, Shri Tej Niwalikar ji suggested the conduction of entrepreneurship workshops for students and strengthen the ED cell. Dr. Shilpa Kabra supported the suggestion and announced the planned one day workshop on entrepreneurship development on 31st October 2023 where Mr. Nihar Laddha would be guiding the students.

- a) Prof. Nidhi Satavlekardiscussed the initiatives undertaken by IQAC for strengthening the teaching and learning resources for development of all students through the use of interactive boards, e-content, etc. Dr. Shilpa Kabra also mentioned that efforts by various departments have led to student success in curricular, co curricular, extra curricular, art circle and sports activities at university and state level. Nikita Katkade discussed the participation of students in various competitions and keeping others motivated so as to realise the objectives of holistic development and mental well being.
- b) Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni highlighted the contribution by Dr. Sandip Anpat in his area of research where he was awarded two patents and published two patents. She also mentioned the success of faculty members in publications in recognized journals. She discussed the departmental efforts for the conduction of workshops/ seminars/ faculty development programs etc to ensure development of faculty members.
- c) Prof. Santosh Shenai apprised the members of the green initiatives undertaken by the college in the campus. These initiatives include placing bird nests (donated by a city furniture shop), compost pit etc.
- d) Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni further discussed the extension activities such as social and community outreach programs conducted by various forums for the welfare of stakeholders. The management members suggested a scheme under 'Welfare of Masses' for improving the well being of anaemic girl students of college through the distribution of good nutritious food. CA Sudhir Taori recounted the advantages of the 'earn and learn' scheme that the current generation could benefit from. Mrs. D Ghare added that students participating in extracurricular and extension activities have better emotional and mental well being and appreciate the dignity of labour.

Mr. Raju More and Mr. Honaji Karhale discussed the possibility of value added courses or experiential learning in the field of data analytics and artificial intelligence along with sponsoring for the economically weaker students through alumni association. All members agreed to participate in the initiative and provide industry orientation to students.
- d) Prof. S M Edke apprised the members of the published advertisement (grant-in-aid) and the in-process faculty appointment roster. Prin B G Jadhav mentioned the challenges of appointing new competent eligible faculty members as per government norms that include the roster approval and seeking NOC form government to recruit new faculty members against the vacant position.
- e) Dr. Sandip Anpat discussed the department initiatives for faculty development programs for professional growth of faculty members through various online government platforms such as Swayam, NPTEL etc.

- a. Various value added / certificate courses such as 'Escalate with Excel', 'Arduino' were designed and conducted at department level. In addition, 'Tally' as part of an add on course, 'Introduction to recent trends in IT' by Nasscom foundation as part of collaboration, management course by Bajaj etc were also conducted as part of collaborative activity.
- b. The Unnat Bharat Abhiyaan project undertaken last year was submitted successfully and five new proposals on rural women empowerment, value added education for rural children, financial literacy for rural region etc were submitted for the academic year 2023-24.
- c. NASSCOM Foundation Laboratory was set up as part of the company initiative for setting up ICT facilities for students. The company also conducted certificate courses such as introduction to recent IT trends in data analytics, data science, artificial intelligence, cyber security, banking & finance etc as part of collaborative activity.

d. Students activities:
