There are two other proposals in further process and a decision from UBA, is awaited.

More than 200 students registered for the course that was postponed due to the examination schedule. In addition, the college has signed MoU with District Skill Development, Employment and Entrepreneurship Guidance Centre, Pune under the scheme of Pramod Mahajan Kaushalya and Udyojakata Vikas Abhiyaan, Maharashtra to establish Mahavidyalaya Kaushalya Vikas Kendra. Soap Making Workshop on 8 Nov 2023 by SDC and Student Forum with more than 50 participants for promoting skill development and entrepreneurial awareness. Value education through 'Kirtan' at various schools in Pune City under Student Forum was conducted at four schools in Pune city.
