The Department of Business Administration had organised Talent Show Competition for students across all the years of BBA and BBA-IB.

Objective:

The primary goal of the competition was to provide a platform for students to display a wide range of talents including singing, dancing, poetry, mimicry, instrumental music, and other creative acts. It encouraged students to step out of their comfort zones, perform on stage, and build self-confidence. As participation both individually and in groups were allowed, it promoted inclusivity and collaboration.

Observations:

All acts were in line with the event rules—no inappropriate content was observed, and performances stayed within the 1–3-minute time limit. The audience, including students, faculty, and staff, showed great enthusiasm, encouraging all performers and creating a lively atmosphere. The judging panel assessed performances based on originality, confidence, stage presence, and audience response. The decisions were accepted respectfully by all participants, in accordance with the rules. Several unique and exceptional talents were identified. Dr. Ashwini Kulkarni, Head of department of Business Administration found it challenging to choose the winner out of the talent showcased.

Key Outcomes:

Total 16 participants from various classes participated, highlighting the cultural diversity within the college, with performances spanning various languages, traditions, and art forms. Participants reported a boost in confidence and motivation, especially first-time performers who overcame stage fear. After crucial scrutiny the judge declared the winners and runner up. In the dance category, Siddhi Shah, Tanisha Adsul, Preksha and Group stood winner, first runner up and



second runner up respectively, whereas Ishita Zalke bagged the consolation prize.
