**Report On Guest Lecture on “Leveraging Lean Six Sigma in Supply Chain”**

The Department of Business Administration, organized a Guest Lecture on “Leveraging Lean Six Sigma in Supply Chain.” The session was delivered by Mr. Nitin Athavle, Assistant Vice President of Kohinoor Group, Pune, a seasoned expert in operations and supply chain management.

**Objective:**

The primary objective of the guest lecture was to introduce the concepts of Lean and Six Sigma and their synergy and to explore how these methodologies can improve supply chain efficiency and effectiveness. It also aimed to equip students with insights into real-world problem-solving and waste reduction techniques.

**Observations:**

The session began with an overview of Lean principles, focusing on eliminating waste (Muda) in various supply chain processes. The speaker also explained key concepts of Lean and Six Sigma methodologies, including DMAIC, process mapping, and root cause analysis, and highlighted how these tools can improve efficiency, quality, and customer satisfaction in supply chain systems. Emphasis was placed on data-driven decision-making and cross-functional teamwork for sustainable improvements.


**Key Outcomes:**
