Introduction

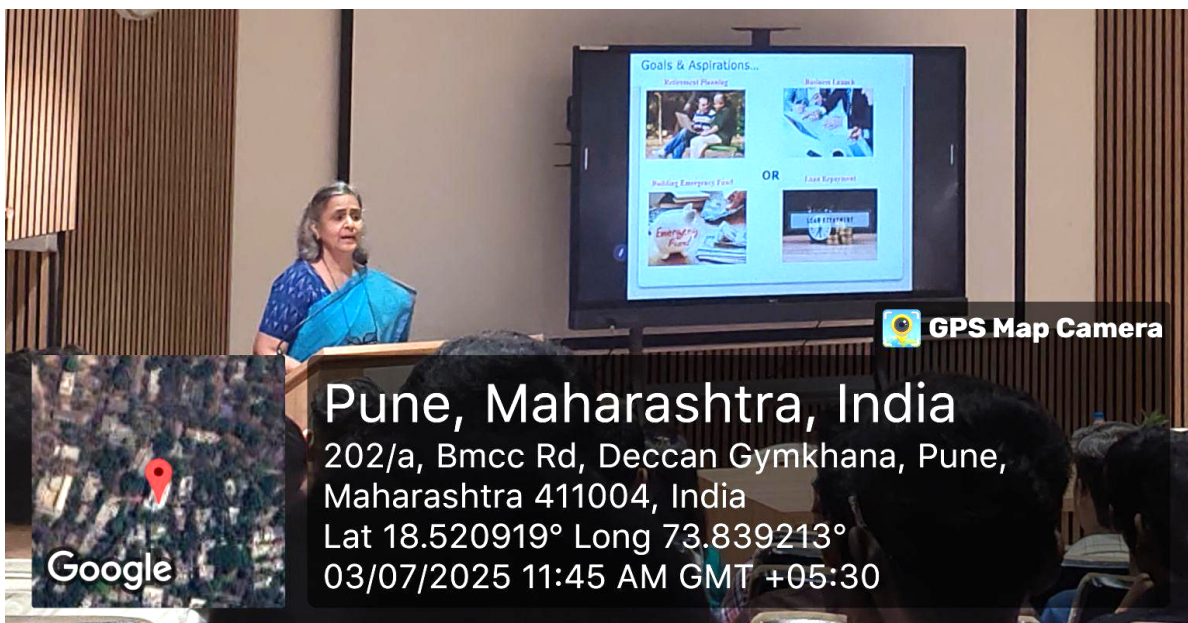
Day 1 : Faculty Introduction

Students were reminded of the importance of prioritizing their mental well-being, with Prof. Ghare stating: “You are the judge of your quality of life.”

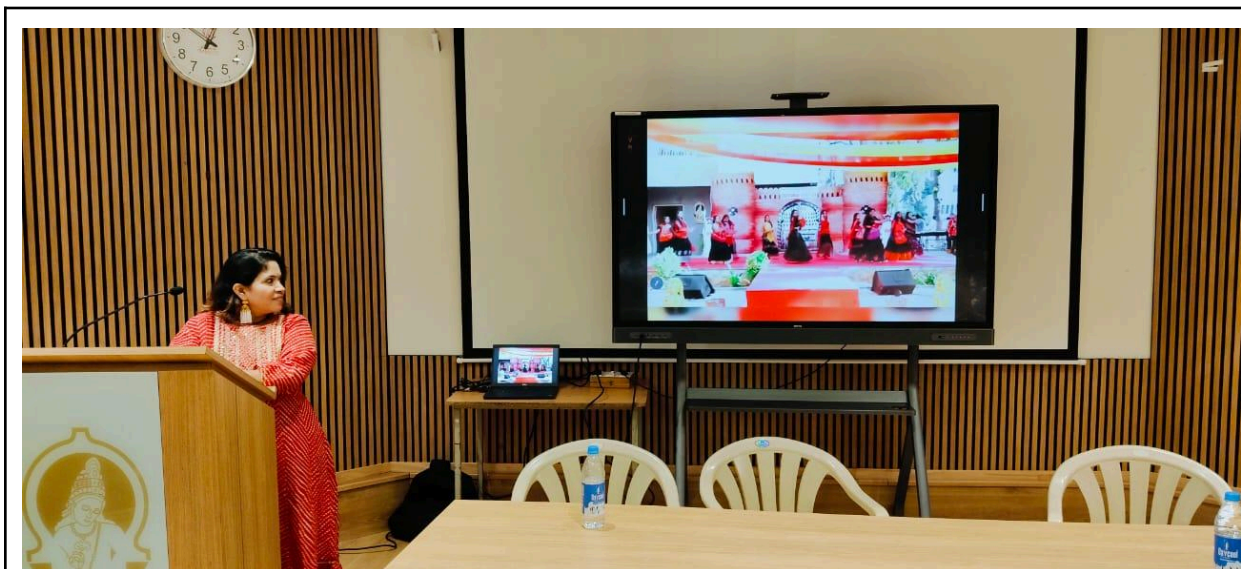
2. Introduction to the Cultural Department

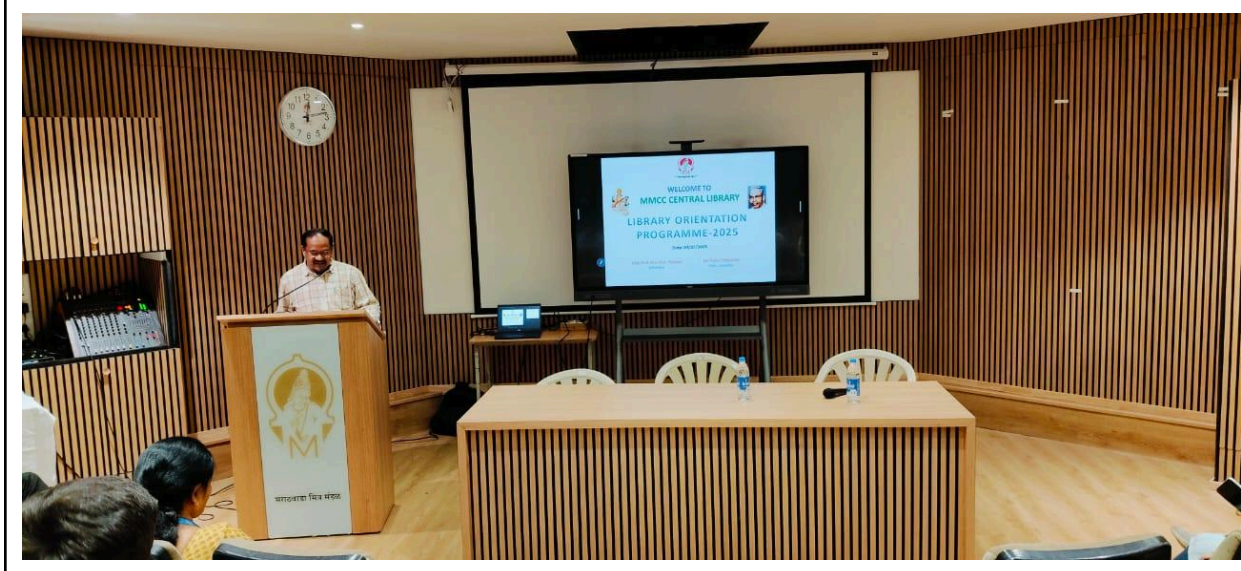
3. Library Orientation
