8. Number of Participants:

A total of 21 student volunteers along with 3 faculties participated in the NGO visit.

9. Brief description of the event:

The Department of Business Administration organized a visit to SOFOSH – Shreevatsa, a well-known NGO dedicated to the care and rehabilitation of orphaned, abandoned, and family-deprived children. During the visit, the student volunteers conducted various fun games and engaging activities for the children, creating an atmosphere of joy, warmth, and interaction. These activities included simple group games, storytelling sessions, and creative play like taking hand impressions of the kids as a token of remembrance. The involvement of students brought smiles to the children's faces and strengthened the purpose of the visit by fostering a meaningful connection.

The visit concluded with the handing over of essential items as a token of solidarity on behalf of Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Commerce. The SOFOSH authorities expressed appreciation for the students' contribution and encouraged them to continue engaging in social initiatives.
