#### **10. Brief description of the event:**

- The Training and Placement Cell collaboratively organized a campus internship drive targeting female students, in partnership with the Nirmaan Foundation, held at Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Commerce, Deccan Gymkhana, Pune.
- The internship program is scheduled for one year with an initial 3-month training session in BFSI (Banking, Financial Services, and Insurance), followed by 9 months of On-the-Job Training at different Piramal Finance branches across Pune. Selected interns receive a monthly stipend of ₹15,000 starting from the first month.
- Each selected girl is provided with a laptop to aid their learning and work activities.
- The selection process involved a pre-interview information session, an aptitude test, and personal interviews.

#### **11. Learning Outcome:**

- Students bridge the gap between classroom learning and real-world practice by applying academic concepts to practical work scenarios.
- Students enhance core skills such as communication, teamwork, problem-solving, time management, and professionalism in the workplace.
- Interns expand their professional networks, gain access to mentors, and clarify their career interests and goals while discovering potential job opportunities.
- Engaging in internships enables students to develop self-confidence, independence, adaptability, and a clearer understanding of their professional interests.
