11. Learning Outcome:

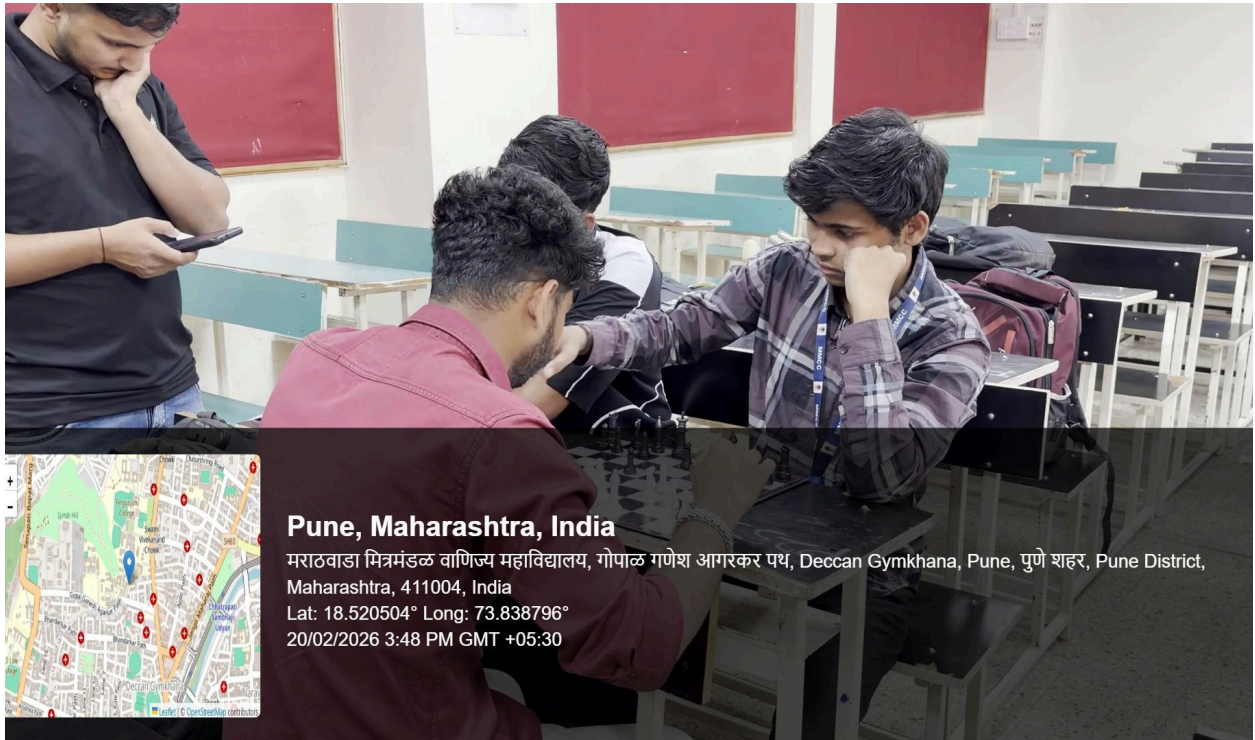
The organized event resulted in several positive outcomes:

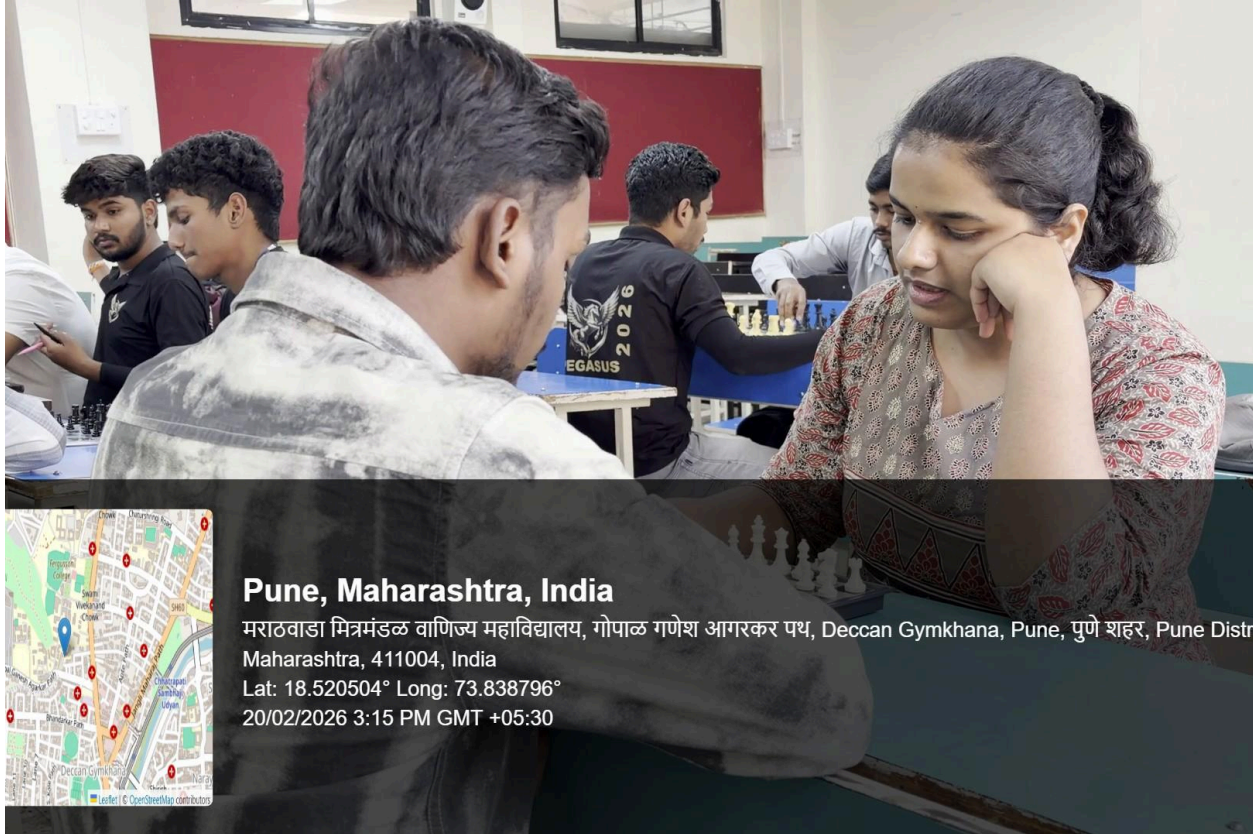
- Students enjoyed the event, expressed gratitude for organizing the activities, and had fun throughout the event.

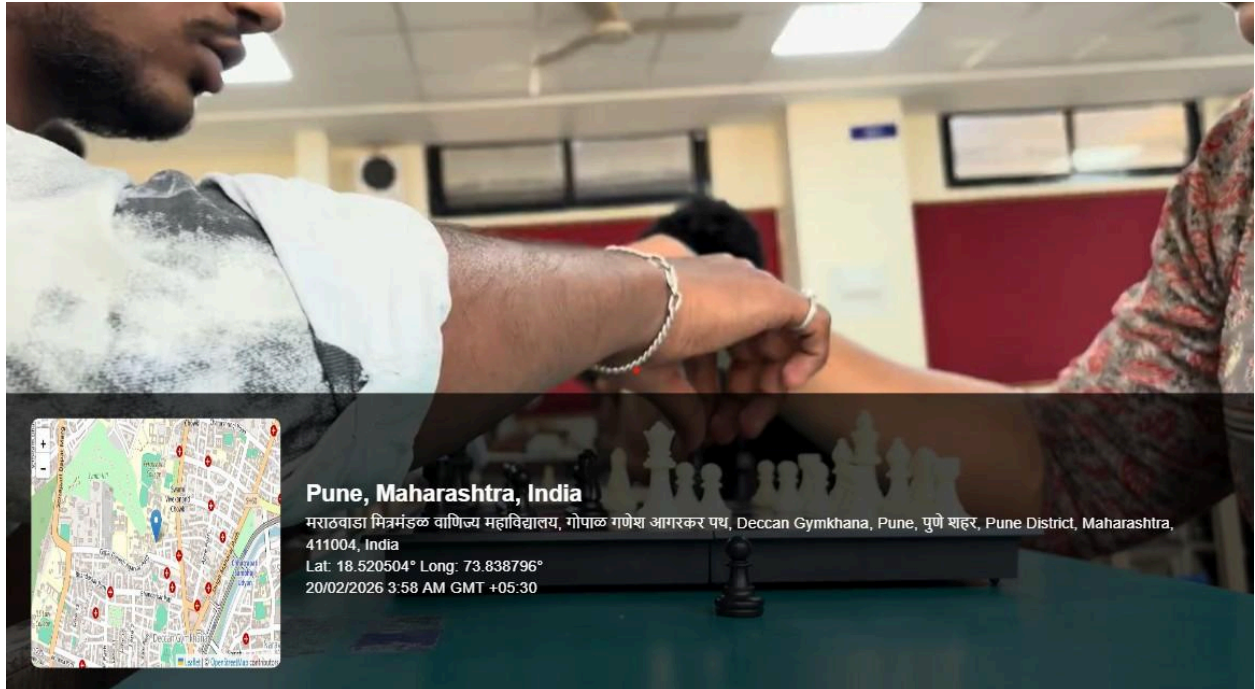
