8. **Objectives of the Program:**

The primary objectives of organizing this event were:

1. To ignite a "Code Athon" (marathon of coding and intelligence), perfectly named for its endurance-testing races in C, DBMS, and AI prompting, honing marathon-level focus.

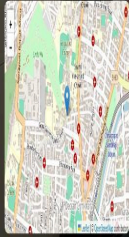

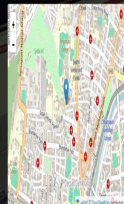

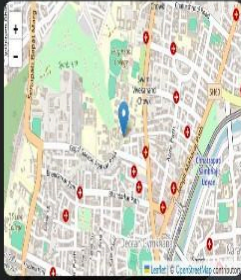
