11. Learning Outcome:

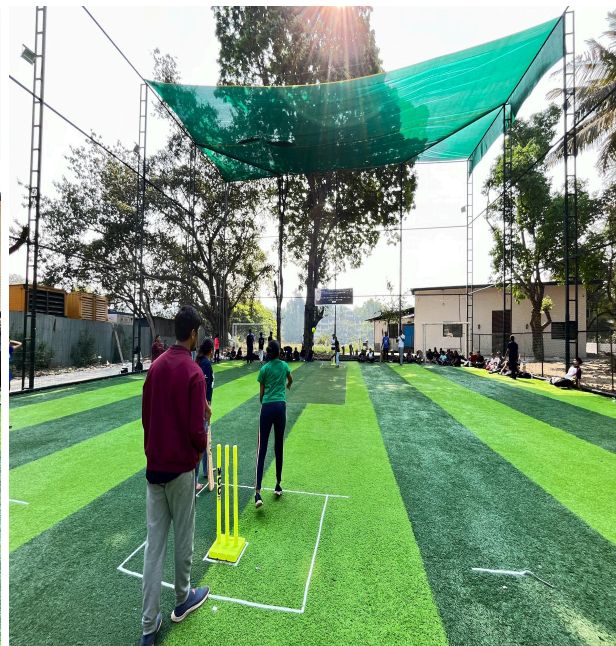
The organized event resulted in several positive outcomes:
