**11. Learning Outcome:**

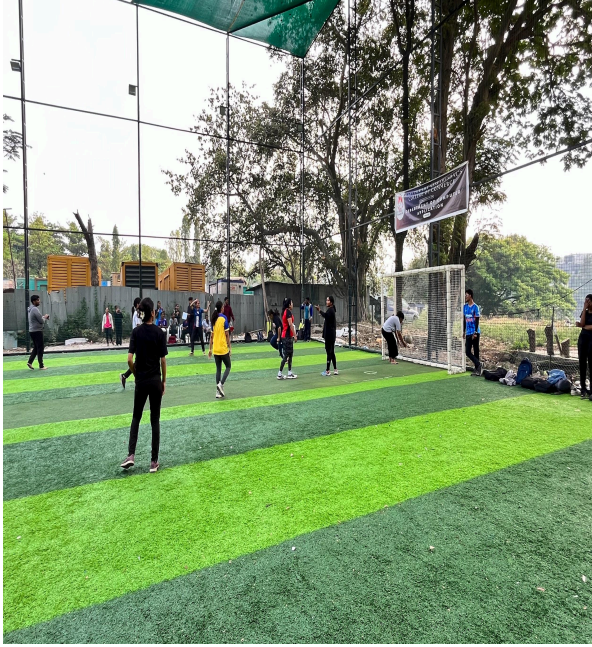
The event yielded several positive outcomes:
