ANNUAL REPORT

ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-26

Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Commerce, Pune, has always been committed to the holistic development and welfare of students through various academic, cultural, social, and personality development initiatives. The Student Development Cell (SDC) plays a vital role in nurturing leadership qualities, social responsibility, creativity, and overall personality development among students.

The Cell actively implements schemes and initiatives introduced by Savitribai Phule Pune University for the benefit of students. One of the flagship initiatives of the Cell is "Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn Scheme," which supports economically weaker students by providing financial assistance and work opportunities within the institution.

During the Academic Year 2025–26, the Student Development Cell successfully organized and participated in several activities and programmes aimed at promoting environmental awareness, patriotism, cultural values, health awareness, reading culture, skill development, and social responsibility. The major activities conducted during the year are as follows:

1. The Cell successfully implemented the "Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn Scheme" from August 2025 to February 2026 for economically disadvantaged students. A total of 22 students benefitted from the scheme. The total expenditure incurred was Rs. 3,41,275, out of which 90% (Rs. 3,07,148) was funded by Savitribai Phule Pune University and the remaining 10% (Rs. 34,127) was borne by the college.
2. International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21 June 2025 in collaboration with Savitribai Phule Pune University and the Government of Maharashtra at Sant Tukaram Maharaj Palkhi Sohala, Gultekadi, Pune. A total of 6 students and 2 faculty members participated in yoga, pranayama, and meditation sessions promoting physical, mental, and spiritual well-being.
3. On 8 July 2025, the "MMCC Go Green – Cycle Rally and Tree Plantation" programme was organized to promote environmental consciousness, fitness, and sustainable practices. The initiative, conducted in collaboration with Savitribai Phule Pune University, included a cycle rally and tree plantation activity, encouraging students to adopt eco-friendly practices and environmental responsibility.

4. A Mega Tree Plantation Drive was organized on 7 August 2025 at Hanuman Hills, Deccan Gymkhana, Pune, jointly by NSS, SDC, and Green Club in collaboration with Deccan Police Station. During the activity, 232 trees were planted with active participation from police personnel, faculty members, and student volunteers. The programme effectively promoted environmental sustainability and community participation.
5. In August 2025, the college organized a series of activities to commemorate Independence Day, including patriotic competitions, tree plantation drives, eco-friendly initiatives, faculty development programmes, a blood donation camp, and the “Har Ghar Tiranga” celebration. These activities promoted patriotism, environmental awareness, creativity, social responsibility, and professional development among students and staff members.
6. The “Vande Mataram – 150 Years Initiative” was organized on 7 November 2025 at the college campus to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the national song “Vande Mataram.” Faculty members and non-teaching staff enthusiastically participated in collective singing and awareness activities highlighting the historical and national importance of the song.
7. The Student Development Cell organized a Slogan Competition on the theme “Vision Document 2047” in collaboration with Savitribai Phule Pune University and the Government of Maharashtra. The competition witnessed active participation from 37 students and successfully promoted awareness regarding sustainable development, inclusive growth, and good governance while encouraging creative expression among students.
8. On 9 December 2025, the NSS Unit and Student Development Cell organized the university-level reading awareness campaign “Shantata Punekar Vachat Aahe” to inculcate reading habits and promote silent learning practices among students and staff members. A total of 435 participants actively participated in the campaign, contributing towards the development of a reading-friendly academic environment.
9. On 13 December 2025, NSS volunteers and Student Development Cell students actively participated in the “Bharatiya Gyanpranali Granth Dindi” organized under the Pune Book Festival 2025. The procession was conducted from Modern College to Fergusson College. The college presented the theme “Indian Mathematics System,” creating awareness about India’s ancient knowledge traditions and cultural heritage.
10. An Essay Competition on “Veer Bal Divas: Child Bravery Day” was organized on 26 December 2025 by NSS and the Student Development Cell to commemorate the birth anniversary of Shri Guru Gobind Singh Ji and honour the bravery and sacrifice of the Sahibzades. The competition witnessed enthusiastic participation from 26 students and promoted patriotism, historical awareness, and creative writing skills.
11. On 12th January 2026 conducted, the “Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan – Pledge Activity” near the Principal’s Cabin. A total of 183 students and faculty members participated in the activity, which created awareness regarding the harmful effects of substance abuse and encouraged commitment towards building a healthy and addiction-free society.

12. On 16th January 2026, a “Workshop on Resume Building and Interview Skills” was conducted for students to enhance their employability and career readiness. The workshop proved beneficial in developing essential professional skills and preparing students for placement opportunities.
13. The “Nirbhay Kanya Abhiyan” was conducted as per the guidelines of Savitribai Phule Pune University on 20 and 21 February 2026. Under this initiative, guest lectures on women’s contribution to society, women’s health, and self-defence training sessions were organized for girl students. The total expenditure incurred for the programme was Rs. 6,708, funded by the University.
14. A documentary screening on the life and sacrifice of Shri Guru Tegh Bahadur Sahib was organized on 26 February 2026 at 8:30 a.m. The programme successfully promoted moral values, historical awareness, and inspiration among students.

The Student Development Cell continuously strives to ensure the welfare, development, and empowerment of students through meaningful activities and initiatives. The programmes organized during the academic year 2025–26 significantly contributed towards the overall personality development, social awareness, leadership qualities, and holistic growth of students.
