8. **Objectives of the Program:**

The primary objectives of conducting this competition were

9. **Participants and Audience:**

11. Brief description of the event:

The Department of Computer Science successfully organized the Induction Programme 2026-27 for the newly admitted first-year students with the objective of familiarizing them with the institution, academic environment, and various student support systems. On the first day, the programme commenced with the Opening Ceremony, followed by the Head of the Department's address and faculty introductions, which welcomed students and encouraged them to make the most of the opportunities available during their academic journey.

Day 1 – Tuesday, 07 July 2026

The programme commenced with the Opening Ceremony, where students were warmly welcomed to the Department of Computer Science.

Dr. Rajeshwari Biradar, Head of the Department of B.Sc. (Computer Science), addressed the students and introduced them to the department's vision, academic expectations, and the importance of discipline, consistency, and active participation in college activities. She also encouraged students to work on projects, participate in internships, and continuously upgrade their skills to remain competitive in the rapidly evolving technology landscape. Her insightful session inspired students to prepare themselves for future careers by embracing innovation and lifelong learning.

Day 2 – Wednesday, 08 July 2026

The second day included informative sessions conducted by faculty members and invited experts on various student support services and career-oriented initiatives.

Dr. Ganesh Patare, Academic Coordinator addressed the students and explained the academic regulations, credit system, internal assessment process, examination guidelines, and the importance of maintaining regular attendance and consistent academic performance throughout the semester.



Prof. Dashrath Gavit, NSS Coordinator and Prof. Shivani Mali, NSS Member, introduced the National Service Scheme (NSS) and explained its objective of developing social responsibility, leadership qualities, and community service among students through various outreach activities.

- Students got motivated to enhance their communication, technical, and AI-related skills, enabling them to become confident, responsible, and industry-ready professionals.

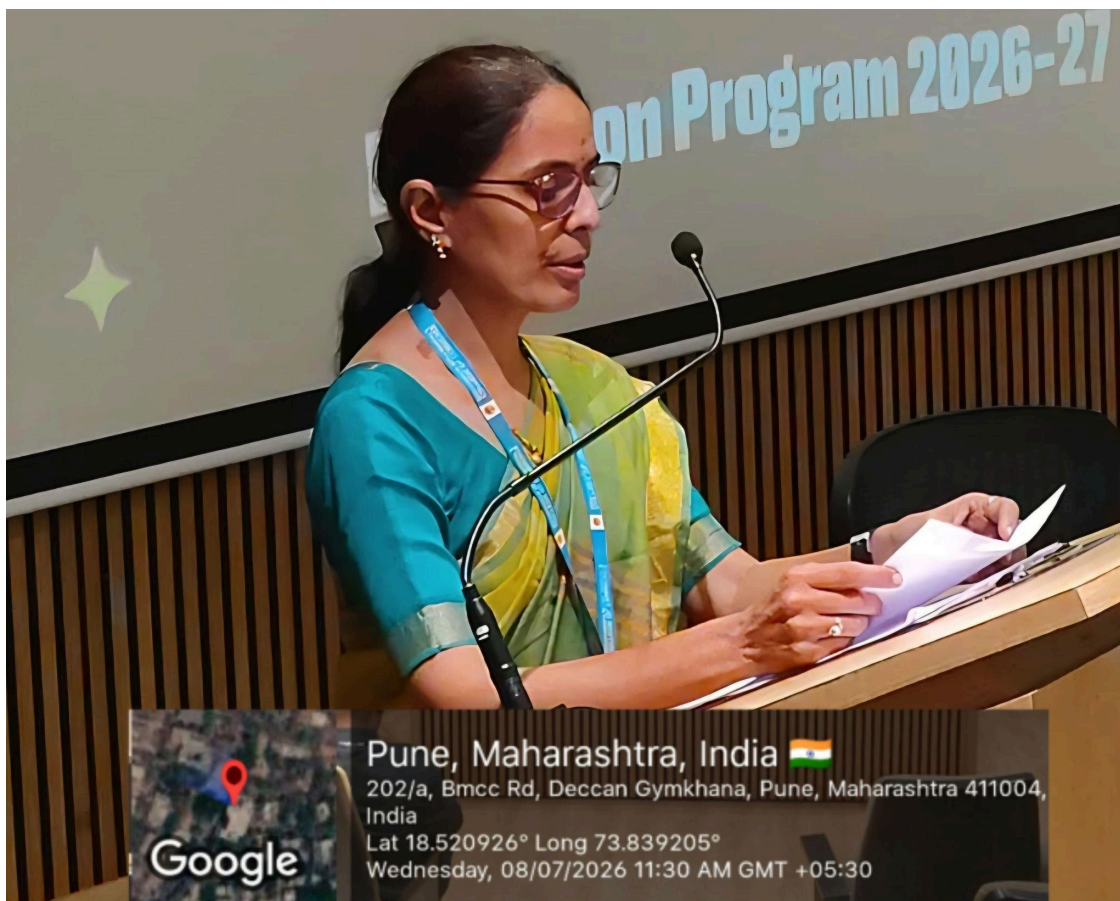

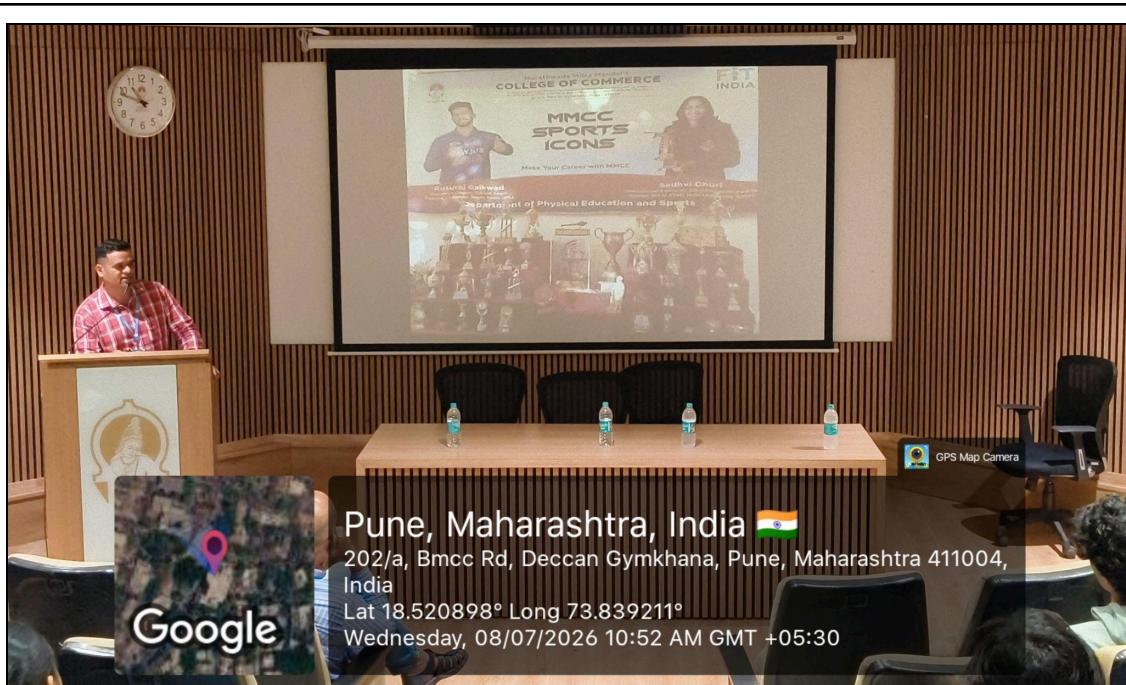

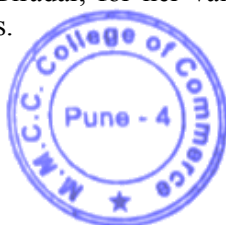
14. Feedback:
