12. Learning Outcome:

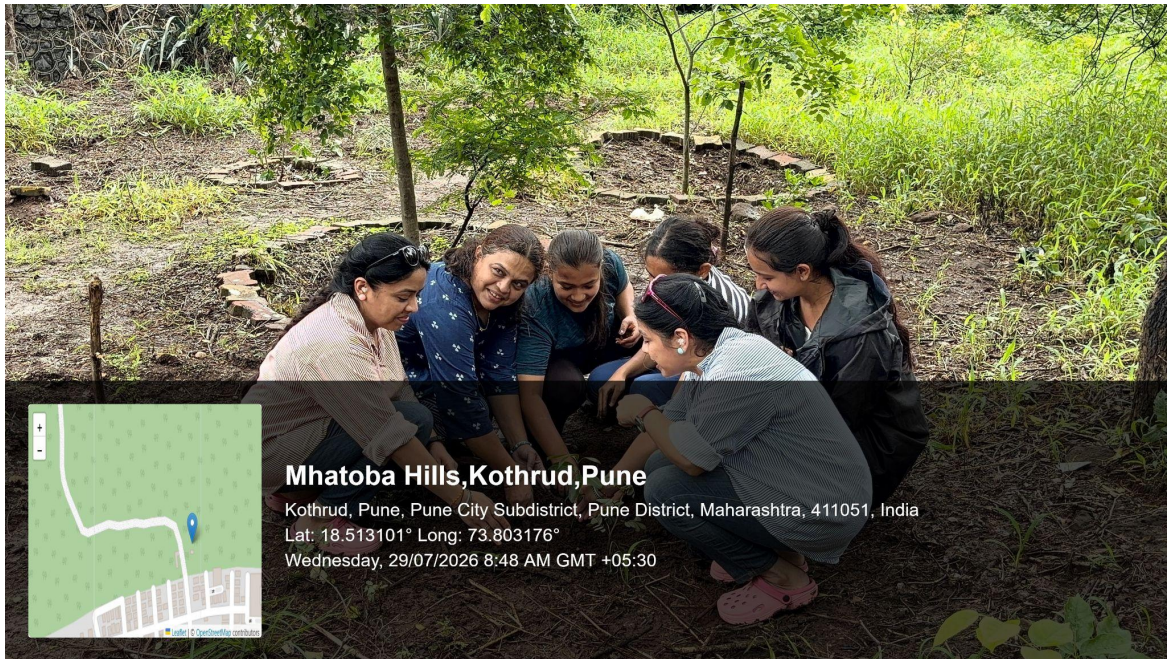
- The **Guru Prakriti – Plantation, Pranayam & Conservation Drive 2026** provided participants with valuable learning experiences beyond environmental awareness.

- The pranayam session highlighted the importance of **physical fitness, mental well-being, and mindfulness** in daily life.

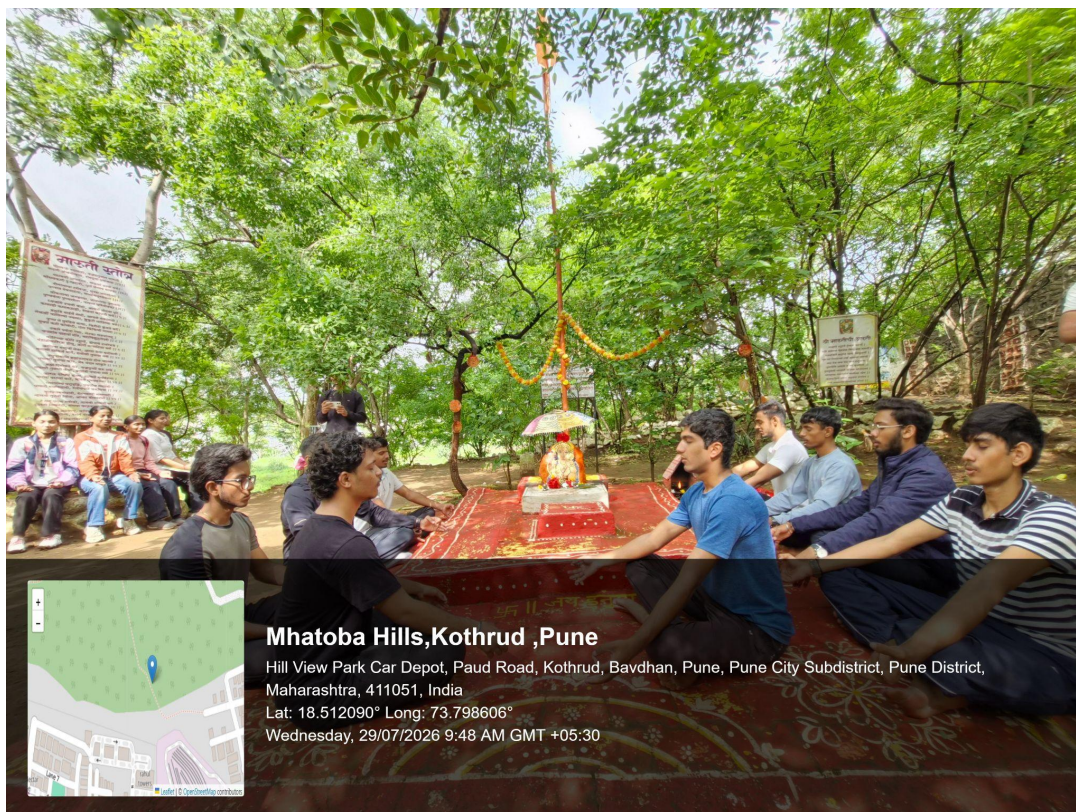


- The event strengthened **teamwork, leadership, discipline, and community engagement** through collaborative participation.
