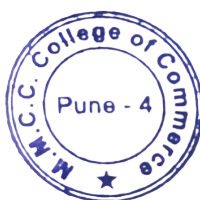

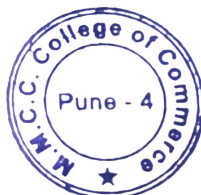

The interactive nature of the session encouraged students to participate actively and develop a broader understanding of human rights and gender sensitivity.

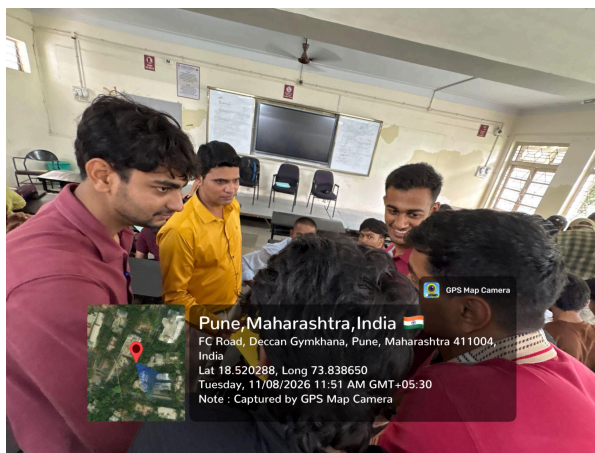
12. Learning Outcomes:

The awareness session resulted in the following outcomes:

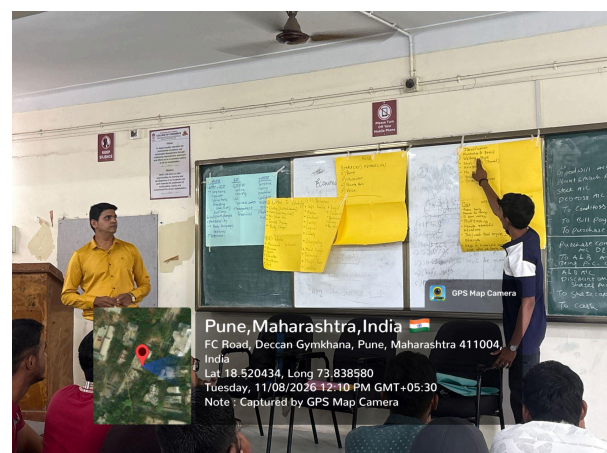
- Students developed greater awareness about fundamental human rights.

- Students were motivated to contribute towards creating an inclusive, respectful, and equitable environment.



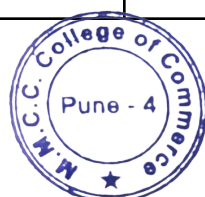
