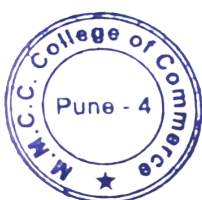

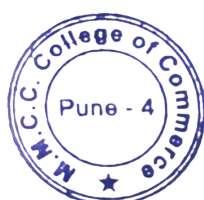

- The session encouraged students to respect intellectual property and practice responsible use of creative and digital content.



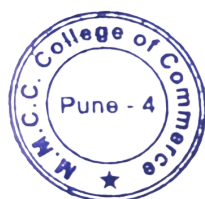
